## Where were you in '93?

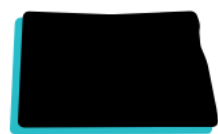
When ND last raised the tobacco tax (25 years ago) it ranked 8th in the nation...Now it ranks 48th among ALL states and the District of Columbia.



ND would make **\$50.83 MILLION** dollars every year by increasing the price of cigarettes by \$1.50

**INCREASING TOBACCO TAX = LOWER YOUTH SMOKING**

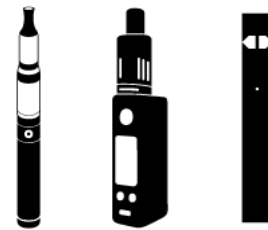
A \$1.50 increase would **PREVENT 5,200 youth** from becoming adult smokers!
