Features of the New License Include:

- Guilloche Security Design Preprinted designs using lines and colors that are difficult to reproduce. A custom designed background pattern using a North Dakota landscape is used.
- Laser Perforation Embedded into the card stock, this feature is not noticeable until held up to a light source, which reveals the State Initials ND.
- Overlapping Data preprinted and perforated features are "overlapped" with other variable and static fields.
- · Ghost Portrait
- Ultraviolet Ink (UV) When Laminate is illuminated with a UV light, the Gold ink glows as Green.

Laminate




Each card is laminated with a tamper resistant coating that increases the card's durability and security. The front laminate shows an "optically variable" pattern of the words "North Dakota Peace Garden State" with an image of the State Bird that changes color as the license is tilted for viewing. When illuminated with a UV light, the Gold ink glows as Green.

- Redundant Data Date of Birth is repeated on back of card.
- 2D Barcode A two-dimensional barcode on the back contains demographic data from the front of the card making the duplication of the document more difficult.

 State Identification cards will include all the same security features as the driver's licenses.



Beginning in 2014

Beginning in 2014, the North Dakota Driver's License Division will begin issuing a newly-designed driver license and identification card. The new cards will be phased in over six years, so you will continue to see the old style license and identification cards in use, until they reach their normal expiration date. The new cards comply with the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) specifications.

Advantages of New Documents

The major advantage of the new license and identification card is an improvement in fraud prevention measures. These added security features include machine-readable technology, improved printing, image overlap, and enhanced laminate. They combine to reduce to the maximum extent possible the ability of a third party to counterfeit a license.


